During the summer it is important for your child to continue to practice the skills they have learned this far. You can help with this by encouraging your child to read and practice their math skills over the summer. A few ways you can encourage your child this summer are:

- Use chalk to practice math skills outside
- Take trips to your local library
- Share books that you loved as a child

There is also a page for your child to fill out the characters, setting, problem and solution of their favorite book that they read over the summer. These are skills that we will be quickly reviewing at the beginning of the school year and are very important foundational skills for all second grade math units. Encourage your child to practice their doubles, doubles +1 and recognizing odd and even numbers throughout the summer.
